



STANDING RULES FOR CONDUCT OF THE BUSINESS FOR THE 2017 AFT-OREGON CONVENTION

1. AFT-Oregon Convention Delegates shall wear the official delegate convention badge issued by the Credentials Committee.
2. The delegation of an AFT-Oregon Local shall be seated together during the Convention sessions. Meetings are open to all interested in attending, but non-delegates must be seated in the designated area.
3. When addressing the Chair, a delegate shall give their full name and their Local.
4. Delegates may not speak more than five (5) minutes on a subject, or more than twice to the subject on the same day, without permission granted by a majority vote of the delegates, without debate. A delegate may not speak more than once to the subject if a delegate who has not spoken, desires to do so.
5. Any Amendment to a Resolution must be presented in writing signed by the maker and the seconder, to the AFT-Oregon Secretary. (An electronic motion form is available at designated computer stations on the convention floor in addition to paper motion forms).
 - a. When the maker is recognized by the Chair, they will identify the Resolution by a name or number.
 - b. The maker shall state the Amendment to the Resolution as written.
 - c. The Chair will repeat the Amendment to the Delegation, and invite the maker to speak to the Amendment.
 - d. The maker will then speak to the Amendment to the Resolution.
6. If granted, a non-delegate Local member may speak after all delegates who desire to do so have had an opportunity. Non-delegates shall speak no more than once to the subject and for no more than three (3) minutes. After recognition by the Chair, the non-delegate will give their name and Local, and state that they are not a voting member to the 2017 AFT-Oregon Convention.
7. If there is no objection from the Delegation, the Chair shall have the privilege of rearranging the agenda for the most efficient use of time and resources.
8. Business interrupted by a recess of the meeting shall be resumed at the point where it was interrupted.
